Fourth Grade Presentation

Fourth Grade

- Goals
 - o Grade level goal: Increase small group math instruction
 - Personal goals: Both fourth grade teachers will work to maintain a great effort to maintain a positive environment in their classrooms and interact positively with all students.
- Plan of action
 - Kindergarten reading buddies
 - Whole and small group instruction
 - Daily fluency practice at home and at school
 - o Daily math fact practice at home and school using Reflex
 - Weekly M-Comp practice (timed and untimed alternating)
- Successes!
 - o 84% to 83% on benchmark in math (fall to winter)
 - Reading Street and Math review Kahoots (game-based quizzes) have improved Reading Street and math test scores
 - o Composting, gardening, and worm gardens
- Challenges
 - o Reading fluency benchmark scores 79% to 76%
 - Lack of parental support is part of the problem (9 of 27 students consistently turning in assignment)
 - Random recesses support students in completing their work (kids that don't go to the activity if they need to complete work)
- Next Steps
 - Continue daily instruction
 - Continue M-Comp practice
 - Continue using Reflex
 - o Child study team process for four students
 - Continue buddy reading
 - o Continue daily fluency practice in school and at home
- Additional Information

- The CSIP is due March 30th
- The literacy goal is focused on phoneme segmentation for kindergarten, reading fluency for grades 1-3, and comprehension for grades 4-5. For below-benchmark students, first sound fluency will be used for kindergarten, nonsense word fluency will be used for 1-2, and DORF will be used for grades 3-5.
- It was asked why there are not numerical scores placed for the progress monitoring tools for grades k-2. Those measures are not re-tested in winter or spring, so the students' goal is to meet the fall benchmark
- The math goal is to meet or exceed the national median ROI by grade level in math measured by MCOMP
- To meet the literacy and math goals, teachers will engage in:
 - o Purposeful planning,
 - o Utilize the SIPO protocol (instructional strategies for ELL students),
 - Deliver explicit instruction,
 - Utilize the explicit vocabulary routine,
 - o The standards-based instructional cycle,
 - o And focus on planning data-based skill-based instruction
 - o Participate in vertical integration teams
- Behavior goal is yet to be determined
 - o Generally our behavior is excellent at Oakdale
 - o The goal will be based on how many office referrals we will have
 - Brain Booster techs will be trained to teach mediation skills to students in order to prevent conflicts and prevent office referrals
 - o Teachers will implement
 - CHAMPS to better communicate routines and expectations in the classroom.
 - Self-manager programs
