Oakdale Mid Year Summary Review March 19, 2014

Oakdale hired four interventionist aides to provide support to our Tier Two and Three students. As of February 18, 2014 we have spent \$17, 136.20 on aide salary and benefits. As a result, our CBM benchmarks show improvement and growth of students in need of support. In addition, we held to professional development on February 26, 2014 to support our school goals for the 2013-2014 school year. The cost for the professional development was approximately \$700.00. The professional development focused on teaching strategies to increase opportunities to respond, walk through data, and strategies to ensure the alignment with both district goals, and Oakdale's goals to increase CBM measurements to 80% mastery per grade level in both reading and math. In addition, our teams have held PLC meetings twice per month and use the data collected to drive decision-making in lesson planning and instruction.
