Parent Teacher Conferences

It's that time of year - Parent Teacher Conferences will be held on Sept 22nd and 23rd. The window to sign-up is from September 8-15, 2021. Wednesday, September 22 will be the virtual conferences similar to last year, with Thursday, September 23 as our in person conferences. Below are the directions on how to schedule an appointment:

- **Login to your Skyward Family Access** - If you have more than 1 student in Canyons School District Schools, choose All Students
 1. On the left side click the Conferences tab

Note:

 - Only one appointment can be scheduled per teacher, per student;
 - If guardians maintain separate households, they must login separately to schedule individual conference times for their student(s);
 - If you have more than one student, the system will allow you to schedule them at the same time with two different teachers, however a warning will appear because this will double book you;
 2. Click on "All Conferences" next to the student's name you wish to schedule a conference for;
 3. Click on "Select a Time";
 4. Choose the time you want and click "Select" next to that time (Status for that time slot must be open or select option will not appear);
 5. A window appears showing the appointment information, click "Save";
 6. You will receive a confirmation email. You will also receive a reminder email five days before, and two days before your scheduled appointment.

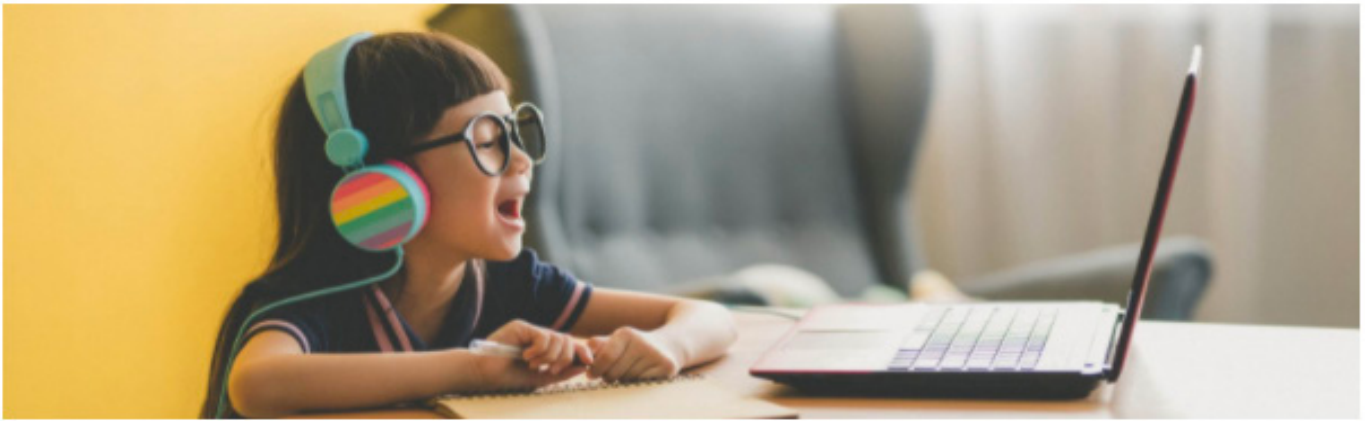

Canyons Announce: Dates and Times for SALTA Testing

Does your child have a strong sense of curiosity, a need to explore subjects in surprising depth, and ability to quickly learn complex information? If so, your student might be a candidate for Canyons District's SALTA magnet program for advanced learners — and the time for applying to test into the program for the 2022-2023 school year is coming soon.

SALTA — Supporting Advanced Learners Toward Achievement — serves students who demonstrate significantly high cognitive and academic abilities in comparison to peers. Students in kindergarten through the seventh grade can apply online to test into the program starting Tuesday, Sept. 7. The deadline for applying is midnight Friday, Oct. 1. Unfortunately, we are not able to accept late applications.



PBIS Rewards:

This year we have implemented a system called PBIS Rewards. PBIS Rewards is a system that allows all teachers and staff to recognize students and/or class groups who are following our school rules to; Be Safe, Be Responsible, Be Respectful, so we are Ready to Learn. Students and/or classes can earn a point for each rule they exhibit. Examples include students in the cafeteria who are seated and not out of their seats - they could earn a point for being responsible, or a student who may be walking around the cafeteria, they earn a point for being respectful when asked to sit down and do so without arguing. Another example could be when students are ready to go out and have cleaned up and are seated, the whole class can earn points.

Students can have an opportunity to spend points through raffles, stores, special events, and classroom rewards. Student's points accumulate, like a bank. Friday, we had our first PBIS Store. We had approximately 95% of our students come through the store to purchase items. It was terrific to see the enthusiasm and excitement of students as they shopped.
